

Course Outline **Social Studies 11 WebCT Course**

To log in to the course click: virtualschoolbc.ca

- The WebCT browser version of Social Studies 11 allows students to complete Social Studies 11 from any Internet connected computer. The student is able to print out activities or question sheets and complete them offline, then submit them online. The WebCT version allows students to access the course by using a personal username and password.
- This self-paced version allows students to progress on their own pace.
- All portions of this course can be completed away from a learning centre, except for the three tests.

Textbook

- The textbook used in the course is Canada: A Nation Unfolding by McGraw-Hill.

Activities

- The activities in Social Studies 11 are labeled A, B, C, etc.
- Some are associated with appendices (readings). If this is the case, they will be labeled with the same letter as the activity with which it is associated.
- Activities need to be submitted through the internet to be marked by an instructor.
- Most are worth marks, but some just have to be handed in - to find out, view the mark sheet.

To Start

Go to the "Course Content" icon on the homepage and follow it through the course - making sure to hand in all of the assignments, do all of the readings and understand all of the Key Concepts and People and Terms.
